<sup>4</sup> In combination with one or more of the other races listed. The six numbers may add to more than the total population, and the six percentages may add to more than 100 percent because individuals may report more than one race.

<sup>5</sup> This category is composed of people whose origins are from the Dominican Republic, Spain, and Spanish-speaking Central or South American countries. It also includes general origin responses such as "Latin" or "Hispanic."

<sup>6</sup> "Spouse" represents spouse of the householder. It does not reflect all spouses in a household. Responses of "same-sex spouse" were edited during processing to "unmarried partner."

<sup>7</sup> "Family households" consist of a householder and one or more other people related to the householder by birth, marriage, or adoption. They do not include same-sex marriage couples even if the marriage was performed in a state issuing marriage certificates for same-sex couples. Same-sex couple households are included in the family households category if there is at least one additional person related to the householder by birth or adoption. Same-sex couple households with no relatives of the householder present are tabulated in nonfamily households. "Nonfamily households" consist of people living alone and households which do not have any members related to the householder.

<sup>8</sup> Husband-Wife Family was categorized as Married-Couple Family in the 2000 Census, but was defined exactly the same.

<sup>9</sup> For the 2000 Census, Rented or sold, not occupied was classified as one category, unlike the 2010 Census, in which it was classified into two separate categories. 2000-2010 change is only provided for Rented or sold, not occupied.
